Domestic Player Age Group Exemption Policy

Overview

The FDBA is committed to providing a safe and supportive environment for all participants. When a player has been affected by developmental delays they may be eligible for an age group exemption request to participate in a competition below their classified age group.

An age group exemption request form must be lodged by the player's Domestic Club to be considered by the FDBA Match Committee. **Requests will not be considered without supporting documentation.**

An exemption cannot be granted if the player may impact the safety of other participants in the requested age group.

Please note that an inability to field enough players to form a team is not an acceptable reason to request for a player to play 'down' an age group.

If a player wishes to play with friends who are only eligible for an older age group they are permitted to play 'up' an age group in accordance with the FDBA Domestic Player Age Group Eligibility Policy.
